To get the most out of your scheduled time and create a product that you can use Come prepared:

PSA can be used to create an awareness of an organization, it's services or needs. For example Meals on Wheels, delivers meals or need volunteers. They can also be used to promote an event such as a fundraiser, road race or food drive. An event specific PSA must be done 30 days in advance of the event in order to have time to edit and broadcast the event to get the most value.

Planning Your PSA

The day of your PSA, have a script, prepared and **rehearsed**. You will have 2 opportunities to get your message out there and we will take the best cut.

- Include: Who, What, Why, Where, When and Contact.
- 90 words are about 30 seconds
- Use conventional language and avoid technical terms
- Have no more than 2 people to convey your message

Please send your script to Studio@LakeCAM.tv at least 5 days prior to the day of your production for review.

Prepare any visuals that will accompany your PSA and have them ready on a USB drive.

- Image size 1920 x 1080 horizontal
